**SEVIS, TSA AND VISA INFORMATION**

**SEVIS REGISTRATION – COMPLETE BEFORE APPLYING FOR VISA. RECEIPT OF PAYMENT REQUIRED FOR VISA PROCESSING.**

**Student and Exchange Visitor Program:** SEVIS is a US government organization for monitoring international students. Students must maintain 22 hours of attendance per week to be considered full-time students. Pursuing a Professional Flight Training course with a certified flight school meets this requirement. **You can also file and pay the SEVIS fee through Western Union.**

**TSA REGISTRATION – TSA (Transport Security Administration) clearance requires approximately 7 working days from the time of first registration. To prevent delays in commencement of flight training, all students must start the TSA registration process immediately after receiving their I-20 form.** Separate TSA registration is required for all three stages of flight training i.e. Private (Initial), Instrument and Commercial (ME). Registration fee is US\$ 130.00 for each stage (total fee is US\$ 390.00). Fee payment for first stage is required only after correctly completing all steps for TSA registration (see instructions below).

**TSA PAYMENT IS NOT REQUIRED FOR VISA PROCESSING. Payment will be made by Dean International Inc. once you arrive in Miami FL - USA. TSA processing fee is part of your flight training package.**

**TSA FORM COMPLETION INSTRUCTIONS**

Given below are details for TSA website and completion guidelines. Please get started as soon as you receive your I-20.

**'PROVIDER ACCEPTED' notification should be visible on successful completion of all steps and upload for processing. Payment is expected after this stage. TSA PAYMENT IS NOT REQUIRED FOR VISA PROCESSING.**

TSA: <http://www.flightschoolcandidates.gov>. Create your new account on their website and **they will provide you with a password, to the email you provide during account creation process.**

**You may be asked to change your password during first login (make sure you remember your User ID and Password - User ID and Password are case sensitive).**

**LOGIN TO YOUR ACCOUNT**

Only the first two Parts are to be completed (Part 1 – Candidate Information and Part 2 – Request for Training) – Together they have 9 steps **(all items in red are necessary).**

Important:

- 1) Make sure you have a scanned color copy of your passport saved on your computer **to upload in step 9.**
- 2) After completing information on a page make sure you **SAVE** information by clicking on **SAVE BUTTON** as applicable.
- 3) After completing all steps (end of Step 9) - **go back to Home Section** – correct any errors if indicated (CLICK on EDIT prompt to make your changes and save after making changes).
- 4) No errors – **SUBMIT** your application by clicking on **SUBMIT BUTTON** on HOME section

Select **Passport** from drop-down list  
Click **Browse Button** and locate the scanned copy of your passport on your computer. **Click Upload / Save.**  
**After completing Step 9 - go back to HOME section and make sure there are no errors. Once all errors are corrected - click SUBMIT icon on same page.**

**VISA INFORMATION**

**On completion of your SEVIS registration, proceed for your visa interview with the US Embassy/Consulate.**

On arrival in USA, Dean International Inc. and Vision Flight Training Inc. will provide guidance with all formalities.

**All expenses and fees except those indicated below are part of the package price as explained in the 'COST SUMMARY AND PAYMENT SCHEDULE FOR ALL SERVICES' section of this package.**

**Expenses related to VISA processing and TSA:**

**Note: Fees may change without notice. Confirm the latest fee schedule by contacting the embassy or consulate near you or visiting US embassy website.**

**Documents required for visa processing by US Embassy/Consulate:**

- 1) Passport with a minimum validity of one year.
- 2) I-20 form issued by school.
- 3) Proof of registration with SEVIS.
- 4) Bank statement and/or a loan approval statement from a bank (reputable bank in India or USA) demonstrating that you and /or your sponsor (parent and/or legal guardian) have the financial resources to pay for the entire flight training course and can afford living in the United States without work. This amount should be greater than US\$ 37,000.00.
- 5) Ability to satisfy the interviewing officer that you will return to India after completion of training (proof of property /assets in India).

**NOTE: ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS MAY BE REQUESTED BY THE EMBASSY TO APPROVE VISA REQUEST. WE DO NOT PROMISE OR GUARANTEE THAT A VISA WILL BE ISSUED. IT IS THE SOLE DISCRETION OF THE US EMBASSY OR CONSULATE.**
